Electoral Roll

Every year the parish church holds an annual meeting to receive various reports, to discuss matters of significance and to elect church officers including the Parochial Church Council. This year our meeting will be on 14th April after the 10.00 service. Please put a note in your diary.

To attend and vote you need to be on the Electoral Roll. This year a NEW roll must be prepared and no names are carried over from the old one. Put briefly, if you are a member of the Church of England and live in the parish and/or worship in the church you are entitled to apply to have your name on the roll.
