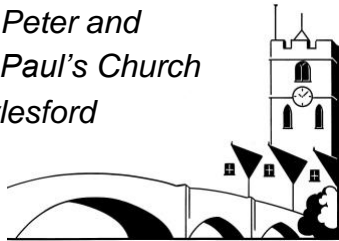

Thursday 8th: Choir Practice -Juniors: 6.30-7.30pm. Full Choir: 7:45pm – 9:15pm.

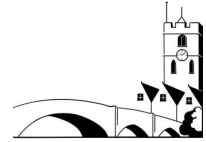

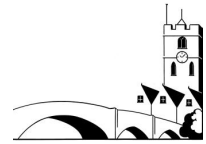

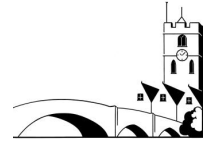
